Tournament Rules

- USA and MAHA Rules apply except where amended below.
- (2) 20 minute halves
- All goals must be scored from the attacking side of center rink.
- Tied games will be decided by a sudden victory.
- There are no goalies!
- Minimum # of players per team is 3, Maximum is 6. 3 players will be on the rink for each team.
- Sportsmanship is expected by all players and spectators.
- 1 referee will be used for each game and penalties will be enforced. Minor penalties (tripping, slashing, and bench penalties) will result in a goal for the other team plus puck possession. Major penalties will result in ejection from the tournament with no replacement.
- Abuse of the officials is a major penalty.
- There is no checking!!
- There are no slapshots, they will be a minor penalty.
- Players can't lift the puck above knee level, will result in change of possession.
- Players can't lay his/her stick across the goal, or fall or lay on the court to protect the goal. This is a minor penalty.
- No offsides!!
- If the puck is out of play, the referee will determine possession. Defending team must provide two stick lengths to their opponent upon re-entry and play must start immediately.
- There will be a center rink face-off to start the game and the second half. Otherwise, teams will be required to wait on their side of the red line for goals scored and minor penalties. Defensive teams can engage the offensive teams once the play starts moving up the court. The offensive team must move the puck up the court quickly on the referee's whistle.
- Player substitution- players may be substituted on the fly.
- Rules subject to change!!
- Unsportsmanlike conduct by a team's players, coaches, or parents will result in a goal for the opposing team on the discretion of the referee. So don't give the referee a hard time!

Equipment Requirements

- **Mandatory:** Helmets (HECC approved), Face protection full cage or shield, hockey gloves, protective cup, shin guards, inline skates (indoor with soft wheels, no brakes, rink safe w/ no hazardous parts), hockey stick (wood, aluminum, and graphite sticks are allowed), inline or ice hockey pants, elbow pads. **Optional but recommended:** Shoulder pads, girdle, and mouth guard and neck guard.
